Social/Emotional Development:

- Shares and takes turns

- Communicates feelings to others
- Helps with classroom jobs and cleaning up classroom
- Follows directions

Spiritual Development:

Intellectual Development:

- Recognizes uppercase and lower case letters
- Recognizes letter sounds
- Starts to blend a consonant with a vowel

- Sorts objects
- Counts 1-50
- Recognizes numbers 1-20
- Knows positional words
- Matches number to group of objects

- Retell or recall facts from stories
- Writes first name

Physical Development/Gross and Fine Motor Skills:

- Begins to color within the lines
- Cuts with scissors
- Manipulates and shapes play dough
- Walks forward and backward and changes directions on command
- Puts together parts (puzzles, small manipulatives, etc.)
- Draws pictures
